Our agreement with you

The school will:

Your agreement with us

- ensure that your child is suitably equipped (for activities - PE and Far field) and properly dressed (with all clothing clearly labelled).
- support the school's policies and guidelines for behaviour and equal opportunities.
- inform school of anything which you feel may be affecting your child's learning.
- support your child in the completion of homework on time and wherever possible promote opportunities for home learning
- attend parent/teacher consultations and support school events

- encourage your child to feel positive about coming to school, praising achievement and success.
- approach, teachers, staff, parents and pupils in a respectful and non-threatening manner.
- support the school Road Safety Policy with respect to safe parking, so children's lives aren't endangered.

We expect your child to:

- do their best in lessons.
- remember to be polite, respectful and thoughtful towards others.
- enjoy school and make the most of all opportunities.
- follow the guidance in the school's Road Safety Policy.
- stick to our agreed school and class rules.
