



### **THE EDEN PROJECT**

#### Year 5 trip to the Eden project



After a two-hour journey we arrived at 'The Eden Project'. We were all very excited.

We first met with our educational lady, who taught some us vital lessons about surviving in the Rainforest. We were given equipment cards to order in the list of their priority, to help ensure survival!



We were then placed into 3 different tribes – Shelter and materials Tribe, Food Tribe and Health Tribe. We sent off then to explored both the biomes, Rainforest and Mediterranean. We also visited the seed and infinity blue.

In the Rainforest Biome, there were lots of different plants, compared to the Mediterranean. We loved looking at all the different types of plants, ones that you can get juice and food from! You could actually survive in the Mediterranean or the Rainforest! We can't wait to tell you about it!



#### Rainforest Biome



The Rainforest is humid and hot and, in the biome, there are lots of different experiences from different rainforests around the world. There are an abundance of different plants including vanilla palm, ice cream bean, African oil palm, rattan Fiji, miracle berry and frangipani.

The Rainforest Biome had food and water that I would say would taste amazing! The way that all the different plants

grow is amazing! The conditions that they can live in are so cool, and that most of them you could eat! We would love to come back and check how all the plants are growing again in the rainforest.

#### Food

The Rainforest Biome has lots of different foods such as, Coco palm, Pineapple, Hollowheart, Ginger and lots more spices, guava, coffee cherries, Cacao pods (Red, yellow and purple). Dragon fruit, papaya, mango, lychee, coconuts. Almonds, Taro, Cloves, Apple ring acacia, Cocode mer, Sweet Potato, egg (from the birds), Bananas plus many more but there are too many to name them all. The plants are the most important things that give us oxygen.

Health





There was a plant which could cure diabetes called the miracle palm. There were other plants which can heal a serious illness like hollow heart that can help pain relief. Sausage tree helps with skin cancer. Which is very important. About 80% of the world's medicine is from the rainforest.

The bay rum tree was good for cooking and making essential oils. The miracle berry was good for diabetes, cancer, obesity and more. These are quite serious! That's why most of our medicine uses plants because the plants have effects that normal medicine wouldn't.

#### Shelter and materials

The rattan plant is good for rope and it has very sharp edges and the Kombai Tribe go barefoot around the forest.

They build their houses on stilts that can go up to 20 metres high so animals and floods can't get to them. Even when the family is outside, the little child outside still doesn't fall out of their house.

The Kombai Tribe cut down the giant bamboo growing for shelter. They cut it down making axes which were made out of sharp stone. This bamboo had water inside of them which the giant bamboo produced.

#### Mediterranean

The Mediterranean is situated around Greece, Italy, and Portugal. It is much cooler than the Rainforest but being the mediterranean was a lot warmer in the biome. And these are some of the plants. citrus plants. Cactus, 'bougainvillaea, grapes, olea Europaea chillies, olives tree, aloe ferox, a plant consisting of juicy flesh.

The Mediterranean is warm, it has a nice breeze that made it unbearable. It had even more plants than we named, such as a lemon. The flowers are so pretty, the shades of white and yellow that they had were beautiful! And the combinations were so nice. The bougainvillea flowers had cream and white petals but the actual flower itself was white and yellow!

#### The seed

The seed is basically a massive seed. It's a massive seed in a smallish room next to Infinity blue. It's not the actual colour of a seed, it looks like it's made out of concrete or marble. But probably concrete.

The seed is quite interesting, there's not much going on with it. But it is still fascinating that there's a massive seed in a small room!

#### Conclusion

Infinity blue is a smoke machine. It shoots out rings of smoke at a time, when we first gazed at it, its rings of smoke came straight out at us and we all wanted to reach up and touch it. In the end, we went downstairs, and some of us were able to touch the rings of smoke. They were so soft! We all enjoyed the show of Infinity blue, as in, all the holes in Infinity blue shot out smoke, ripples, and rings. We would love to visit Infinity blue again at the Eden Project.

We found it lovely at the Eden Project. The Mediterranean and the Rainforest Biomes were amazing! We would all love

to visit the Eden Project again. There were loads of different plants in both of the biomes as you know, from cacao pods to citrus plants. It's amazing how all those plants can survive in those different biomes!

We would all love to come again, our adventures in the biomes was amazing!




# **BIKEABILITY**

We started off by learning the basics on how to cycle safely. We cycled around the playground lots of times, to learn which direction to look, letting people pass and being able to signal. We also learnt how to do shoulder checks.

We played lots of games to improve our bike control and our safety on the road. In level 2 (on the road) we learnt how to do left turn in, left turn out, right turn in and right turn out. We also learnt how to turn in and out at junctions using the give way lines accurately. Year 5 improved their U-turns and road skills during the bike ability course. We had great fun!
