Dear Parents/Carers,

This past two weeks we have had a busy time in school. The children have been fantastic as always and there have been lots of little achievements all over the school including: performing poems as part of National Poetry Day - the wonderful Walking with my iguana performed by year 4 with the djemba drum as a highlight; Reception and Pre-school had a visit from the police; Year 5 have taken part in a history workshop looking at sources with The National Archive and we are all learning about space during national Space Week.

We were visited by the Sidmouth Learning Community headteachers recently who were looking at writing across the school and sharing our best practice. We have already seen lots of children writing some wonderful pieces including poems, stories, biographies, science investigations and non-fiction pieces. I would draw everyone's attention to the weekly spellings on your curriculum overviews and ask that wherever possible you ensure the children are practising these regularly at home.

#### A big school wide fundraising project

A big announcement we have in this week's newsletter is a shared goal that we have agreed with the PTFA to develop our playground areas for the children. We would like to invest in a trim trail for KS1 and a climbing frame for KS2 as part of a longer term project to develop the outdoor area of our site. I am very grateful to the PTFA for their ongoing help and support. We will shortly be launching a crowd funding page and are planning a number of school and PTFA events to try and raise funds for this. Some of the pictures of what we are trying to achieve are included here to give you an idea of the project.

All of our pupil leaders and school council members have also now been appointed and the first meetings of these will be taking place next week. The first challenge we are setting them this year is linked to play and improving our playtimes.

Thank you to everyone as always for your ongoing support of our school. We have had many new children join us over the first few weeks of term and we have loved welcoming them into our school community. I hope they already have a strong sense of belonging to our wonderful school.

If your child was born between the 1/9/2020 and the 31/08/2021 you need to apply for your child's school place from the 15th November 2024.

# **Flu Vaccinations Consents**

In 2024/25 all children in Primary Schools from Reception to year 6 (inclusive) will be offered the vaccine. The vaccination is free and recommended for young children; it is administered by a quick and simple spray up the nose. Please enter www.nhs.uk/child-flu to access information explaining the vaccination programme which also includes details about the small number of children for whom the nasal vaccine is not appropriate. 





