#### A Message From Mr Pope

Dear Parents and carers,

We have had such a great two weeks in school with our School Summer Fete and transition days! The children have really enjoyed it.

The summer fete was amazing as always! Thankyou for everyone for coming and enjoying what is always a lovely, well organised and joyful event. Many thanks to every member of the PTFA who has been involved in this event but also the many others in our community who ran stalls, gave donations or simply attended to be part of it. A special mention to Teri, the chair of the PTFA for organising the event. Each year the maypole dance and crowing of the fete King and Queen is a highlight of the event and thanks go to Mrs Raffell and Carmen for passing on this wonderful and important tradition that has been happening in our community for many, many decades if not over a century.

The school's transition days have enabled the classes to meet and get to know their new teachers. These transitions are extremely important as we recognise that whilst many children will be really excited there may also be an element of nerves and trepidation as they enter their new school year. The teachers put an emphasis on both getting to know the children and ensuring an understanding of their attainment and progression. The teachers want to celebrate each child. To help with this we have a robust handover where teachers are able to ensure that the high expectations we have of children in the school are transferred from teacher to teacher. This year we have extended and invested in these transition meetings with an extra day of dedicated time to meet with the SENDCO and additional staff meeting time for teachers to work together.

Over the last two weeks, we have also held a pupil voice and the governors' parent voice survey which have been presented to our governing board. These along with an ongoing staff survey are really important to us to gain feedback to enable us to move forward – both positive and where feedback given is constructive. Thank you for those that took the time to complete it. The school is very proud that 94% of you would recommend us which is 10% higher than the national benchmark. We will always strive to improve this through our efforts with the children.

This half term our curriculum revolves around climate issues and how we can teach the children to look after the environment around us. Children across the school have taken part in a variety of activities including biodiversity fieldwork, balsam bashing and a variety of climate workshops. The school is very hopeful that all the work this year will lead to the Eco Green flag Award we are currently applying for.

An important date to note is below. My thanks to teachers who spend a significant amount of time preparing these and the ongoing work each and every day to assess, support and strive to provide an excellent education.


#### **Adventure Island**
