#### A Message From Mr Pope

#### Dear Parents/ Carers,

During this week, the school received an audit from the Devon Safeguarding team. I think it is extremely important we face regular scrutiny over this vital part of our school life & community. This is especially true in light of recent National press and the changes to school inspection around Ofsted's approach. Educating the children in staying safe is central to this but it is also myriad of other things including staff culture, record keeping, training, recruitment, online safety and security, and pupil voice are just some of the areas covered. The school's approach and provision came out of this audit very favourably and the actions we take as staff were positively appraised. I would also like to thank our governors and particularly our safeguarding governor, Teri Murphy whose knowledge, time and commitment were really clear. I can with assurance say that children at Newton Poppleford School are safe and well cared for.

There are some staffing and recruitment updates I would like to share that effect next year. I know many parents would like to know which teacher will be taking which year group next year. This will be announced after the teacher vacancy the school is currently advertising for is filled. This is likely to be in the week beginning the 3rd of July. The reason for this is to give the school as much flexibility as we can in the recruitment of a new member of our teaching staff. We want to reassure parents as we have had a number of applicants for the role and I have and will be conducting numerous tours of our site for possible candidates. There have also been some recent leadership structure changes in the school and Kirsty Singfield is now no longer a member of the senior leadership team. I would like to thank her for her contributions to this point.

Our reading raffle for Accelerated Reader has launched this term and we will be sharing some more details of that with you shortly. Simply put, the children who have read the most (at their individualised attainment level) will have the most chance of being successful in the raffle to win the prizes of a book token or Amazon voucher. We have also started our 'attendanceopoly' weekly game that gives the best attending classes the opportunity for some golden time and a prize.

I also wanted to inform you that we have now set a date for reports to come out to you. They will be in a slightly different format than before and your children will be assessed across the curriculum beyond English and Maths as well as the usual comments. These will come to you on the 14th of July.

Finally, as a school, we are looking at sustainability across our curriculum. The sustainable development goals are a really important part of this and help frame our conversations with the children and we are looking at them in our assemblies. You can find them here:


#### **Childhood Vaccinations**

Starting or returning to school is an exciting time for all children. As they will be mixing with lots of other children, making sure they are up to date with their routine immunisations gives them the best protection from what can be very harmful infections. A list of the vaccinations your child should have had, by age, is available via this link <u>NHS vaccinations and when to have them - NHS (www.nhs.uk)</u>

If you are not sure if your child has had all of their vaccinations, please check their personal health record (the red book) and if you have any questions, contact your child's doctors surgery. If you have an concerns about the vaccinations, you may wish to read about the benefits of vaccination and possible risks to your child if they were to catch these diseases. Your child will be learning and playing with more children when they start their new school and could be at risk of catching preventable diseases if they haven't had all their childhood jabs.



If you are not sure if your child has had all their routine vaccinations, check their personal health record (Red Book) or contact the GP surgery. To get the best protection for your child, they need to have had two doses of MMR vaccine. For a checklist of the vaccines and the ages at which they should ideally be given visit:
